Join OSA as we explore art and nature in beautiful Winter Park, Florida, known as "The City of Culture and Heritage."



Once considered a winter resort, the arts- and culture-filled city of Winter Park is now also a nature lover's paradise. Our first stop is the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art, which houses the world's most comprehensive collection of works by Louis Comfort Tiffany, as well as late 19th- and early 20th-century American painting, graphics and decorative art. Enjoy the OSA guided tour or explore the museum's collections at your own pace. After leaving the museum, we will embark on a one-hour narrated cruise through twelve miles of Winter Park's tranquil lakes and canals. Float by swaying palms, lush ferns, and sub-tropical flowers as you view the Kraft Azalea Gardens, Isle of Sicily, and opulent private homes and estates. *Participants can join one or both events, or you may choose to spend the morning visiting the city's upscale shops, galleries and parks on your own. The bus will return to Orlando at 12:15 pm.*
