National Susan B. Anthony Museum & House

Tuesday, 18 October, 1:30 – 4:00 PM

- **OSA members and their families are invited to visit the National Susan B. Anthony Museum & House as guests of OSA.** This historic national landmark was the home of the legendary American civil rights leader during the 40 most politically active years of her life, and the site of her famous arrest for voting in 1872.
- The home was the headquarters of the National American Woman Suffrage Association when she was its president.
- Susan B. Anthony was the first woman to be honored by having her likeness appear on a circulating United States coin. On July 2, 1979, the U.S. Mint officially released the coin in Rochester, NY.

The event is free to OSA members, their families and friends. Children are welcome.
